

## CCJLSA Poultry Show 2021 – Show Day Information

Welcome to the 2021 Comal County Junior Livestock Poultry Show. This year will have some differences due to the precautions needed to mitigate the risks from the COVID-19 virus that is widespread in our community. Please read the following information to help you have a smooth and successful show.

8-11 a.m.	Sift
Noon:	Broiler Pullet judging, followed by

2 p.m. (following broilers)	Turkey Hen judging, followed by
	Turkey Tom judging, followed by Champion Drive
Following turkey show	Poultry Showmanship – junior – intermediate - senior
Barn cleanup (all are expected to participate)	All birds must be removed from grounds following showmanship, feathers should be removed from show ring, and shavings, etc., swept and bagged for removal. (Any birds on the grounds must be properly secured and cared for.)

### COVID-19 SPECIAL SHOW PROCEDURES

1. CCJLSA COVID-19 plan requires face coverings of the **nose and mouth** at all times in the barns. Anyone not wearing a face covering will be asked to leave. Please see the CCJLSA COVID-19 plan for additional information.
2. Poultry will be housed in the Goat/Lamb barn. Each youth will be assigned their own set of turkey/broiler pens with separation from others to allow social distancing. Please respect social distancing guidelines and do not stage chairs to camp in the barn.
3. Broiler showers should identify two immediate family members to help them bring birds in during sift and show their pen of birds. If your family has more than one youth showing, please arrange for sufficient handlers in a safe manner. Youth will NOT be asked by the poultry committee to handle other pens.
4. Family members are permitted to hold larger turkeys for youth.
5. Smaller calls are planned for 2021 to reduce the number of people in the ring. Pens will be called in small groups; please come promptly to the show ring and adhere to social distancing when entering the ring.
6. Social Distancing between pens will be practiced in the show ring. Please pay attention to and follow directions from poultry committee members.
7. Please review the **CCJLSA 2021 Exhibitors Information Document** (that has been sent to your ag teacher/county agent) for additional guidelines.

## SATURDAY, FEB. 20.

Show Day Order:

**ARRIVAL:** When you arrive, please go (without birds) to **(1)** Wing Band Card table located at the rear of the lamb-goat barn. Get the pre-printed wing band cards with your name and enter your selected pen numbers and mark pullet or cockerel / hen or tom to bring into sift. Social distancing will be required in sift line.

**\*\*\*No birds are allowed in the poultry barn unless they have gone through sift.\*\*\***

**SIFT:** Bring one completed card and one pen (3 broilers or 1 turkey) through the lamb-goat barn to the show ring for **(2)** wing-band check and **(3)** pre-judging.

**(4)** After pre-judging, get your exhibitor card from the table in the show-ring and declare if you will be competing in showmanship. There is not an additional fee for showmanship.

**(5)** Pre-judged pens should be brought directly from the show ring to your assigned pen number in the poultry barn.

**SHOW:** Exhibitors will be called back by pen number. Only the exhibitor showing a pen should be wearing an exhibitor number in show ring. (See [rule book](#) for rules on show attire.)

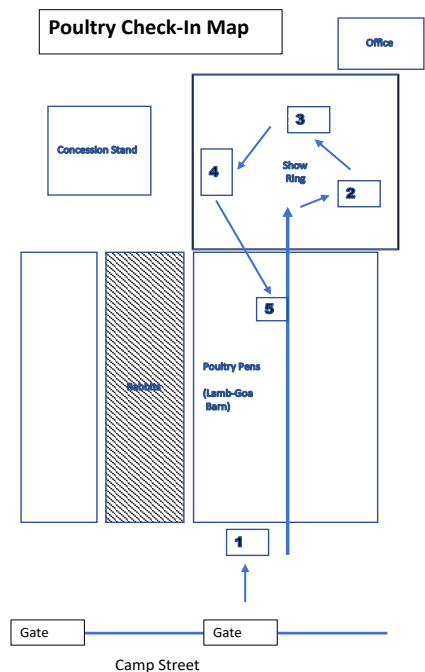
Ribbons will be distributed following each call-back. Do not change positions or leave the ring until your ribbon has been presented. Grand and Reserve Champion buckles will be presented following each champion drive.

(Turkey Grand and Reserve Champion wing bands must be clipped by superintendent before removal from the ring because CCJLS is a terminal show.)

**SHOWMANSHIP:** All exhibitors are encouraged to participate in showmanship. Juniors (3rd-5<sup>th</sup> grade); Intermediate (6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade); Senior (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade). Buckles for all divisions will be presented following senior showmanship. There is no additional fee to compete.

**AFTER THE SHOW:** Exhibitors should remove your birds and all food and water. Remove the pen number and put in the container then dismantle your pen and shovel shavings into the provided bags.

**DECLARE FOR AUCTION:** All birds earning white ribbon or better are sale eligible. Following the show, go to the photography booth to get your photo taken for auction day and to declare which pen you want to sell. You MUST declare and have your photo taken if you will sell a pen—see the [CCJLSA rule book](#) for more information.



## SATURDAY MARCH. 6.

**AUCTION LINE-UP:** Check in at the poultry table in the concession stand area.

- Broiler (6th in sale) check-in is 5 p.m. Saturday.
- Turkey (last in sale) check-in is 5:30 p.m. Saturday.

Note: Due to the earlier species not bringing all animals through the auction, the sale may proceed at a different pace than in previous years, therefore the lineup times are subject to change.
